- 2 pieces of hemmed reclaimed fabric in A4 size
- Line paste in applicator bottle
- Acrylic paints
- Paintbrush
- \$20 per kit (\$25.99 recommended resale price)



### Extra fundraising opportunity

We would love it if your organisation, helped us take an extra step in reducing the textiles being sent to landfill by asking your community for their pre-loved bed sheets. For every sheet donated we will give you a \$5 credit\* to use towards your classroom activity kit.

\* Sheets must be light in colour & viable to be upcycled; max of 5 sheet credits per class kit ordered

\* Sheets to be dropped off or shipped to Greensborough at your cost

### In-Class Activity Kits

We also offer a Sustainable Kit version for class use, using your own paints and paintbrushes.

School kit includes:

- 60 pieces of hemmed reclaimed A4 fabric sheets
- 25 Line paste refillable applicator bottles (1 bottle is enough for 2-3 sheets)

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## Clothing Drive ~ How it works

### Option 1.

- Step 1 ~ Reach out to your community and ask them to go through their wardrobes for clothing they no longer wear.
- Step 2 ~ We suggest that you first organise a pre-loved sale then gather what's left and check it against our Donation Price List.
- Step 3 ~ We arrange for collection of your items
- Step 4 ~ We go through your donated items, check them against our Donation Price List and for usability, and send you the funds you have earned.

### Option 2.

- Step 1 ~ Drop us an email or give us a call to discuss products that your community would be interested in purchasing. If there is a product that we currently don't make but you believe your community would buy we are more than happy to work with you to create a new item.
- Step 2 ~ Reach out to your community and ask them to go through their wardrobes for clothing they no longer wear.
- Step 3 ~ We suggest that you first organise a pre-loved sale then gather what's left and check it against our Donation Price List.
- Step 4 ~ Promote sales through your community. You can either collect orders or your community can place their orders through our store 'ReFashioned by A Fitting Connection' at <https://madeit.com.au>
- Step 5 ~ Orders will be completed and dropped off and fundraising funds will be donated 2 weeks after the close of sales

\$1 Business/collared shirt

\$1-2 Knitted jumpers, cardigans etc (price dependent on yarn fibre)

\$1 Viscose/Rayon knitted tops & dresses

\$1 per Activewear eg. leggings, jacket, tops

\$1 Sweaters

\$0.50 Cotton tanks & tee

\$0.50 Necktie

\$5 Sheets

\$5 Quilt covers

\$5 Blankets

~ Items need to be clean and in wearable/usable condition

~ Items with stains or holes will be accepted at a reduced donation rate
